Our activities:

After the 4th meeting in Siauliai we did several activities – we organized an excursion to an eco-farm where we learned about ecological agriculture, we updated our website and published new information both on the school noticeboards and the school facebook page. We had regular meetings once a week where we planned our work, chose the team for the next meetings and prepared all necessary materials and presentations for the 5th meeting.

VISITING AN ECO – FARM

One Sunday in November we set out for an excursion to the Zerlina eco-farm near Rožnov pod Radhoštěm. They breed about 50 brown goats and produce ecological products such as milk, cheese etc.





We could watch their care about goats and the way they produce ecological products. However, goats are not the only animals in the farm!











At the end of our excursion we tasted their ecological products. Goat milk, various types of cheese, youghurt – really delicious. Yummy, yummy!!


At the beginning of the new school year we welcomed new students in our school and in our Comenius team and informed them about our project activities.

After the meeting in Lithuania we decided to become more active in recycling. The students volunteered in creating special multi-stream waste containers for proper waste disposal. Our Headmaster helped with the design and the cutting of the pieces which were assembled by the students themselves. The new recycling bins were labelled and placed in central posts inside the school building, where they could be easily noticed and the whole school community were informed about them.











Later in November we decided to continue our composting tradition with the collection of fallen leaves and other organic waste into our 'composters'.





We also started the drying process of the river plants that we collected for our herbary.





















Meanwhile we started working on our presentation about **Eco-agriculture** in our country and made preparations for the **5**th **Comenius meeting** that would be held in our city.



We built a beautiful Christmas boat, according to the Greek Christmas tradition, with natural materials (wood and cotton fabric) so as to welcome our guests in a festive mood.

Our activities.

In the meantime we prepared our presentation for Greece. We talked with our students whose parents own small farms and they presented in front of their colleagues the meaning and the importance of ecoagriculture.

In December we used recycled paper and plastic for the Christmas preparation. Our students build up a Christmas-plastic tree in the school-yard and made Christmas ornaments and cards of recycled paper and parts of computer hard discs that are no longer used. So instead of throwing these parts out they got creative and made something beautiful for a great celebration.

Integrated lessons about ecology are also popular in our school.






Our students also adore lessons in Siauliai University in the Botanical garden. They take care, water and fertilize plants.
